

Terri Blackstock has been gifted to write in a way that holds your intrigue. I rarely read any of her books without spending several late nights (12 to 1 AM) trying to see what is going to happen next. From the first sentence she has captures my attention. The events surprise me, and keep me

reading to find out what is going to happen next. Private Justice is the first book in the Newpointe Series, and I felt the hopelessness of the husband, who was arrested for his wife's murder, the frustration of the detective trying to make sure he did what was right even if he had to arrest his friend. I recommend her books to anyone who enjoys reading a "can't put it down" book. In addition to the story line, she weaves in Bible truths that hit home. Her books make me want to spend more time in the Bible, and tell others about how much Jesus loves them and wants a relationship with them.

I just read this on my kindle. As a Christian I wasn't put off by the "warnings" that some Christian lit gets. However, I was put off by the sections that were just plain preachy, and not woven into the story well. I believe that God belongs in every portion of our lives, but this author is clumsy in her integration. The marital issues don't provide any clarity as both Allie and Mark are missing the point. The book doesn't utilize the potential to illustrate how a troubled marriage could be strengthened without a life threatening incident. The voice of Nick could have been so useful but his lack of confidence overshadows the good he could do. I like the plot. I came to like a number of the characters. I just wanted to take a red pencil to the whole thing and tighten it up.

I awarded this story five stars because it was written by a pro. She took an idea and turned it into a five star ordeal. Terri Blackstock's story was about firemen and their families and what a strong bond they have within the community. We began calling our firemen heroes after 911 devastated our country in 2001 by a terrorist attack in the United States. So many firemen lost their lives trying to get people out of the Twin Towers in Manhattan. It seriously pointed out how firemen worked so hard and so many sadly gave so much in helping so many who did make it out in time. She made so many characters come alive in this story called "Private Justice". I enjoyed reading it quickly because there was so much action, I just wanted to find out how many survived. Serial killers have so many reasons why they do what they do and this story took an in depth look at attitudes, feelings, and friendships. I liked the book. It made for an interesting reading. I liked the idea and the bold chances the killer took to execute his plan. There were some interesting surprises throughout the narrative. New people being killed and new bold moves by the killer. It was almost unbelievable the risks the killer took to execute his plan. I felt however that the author did not do a good job developing the police investigation. First on a high profile serial killer investigation, they left the only detective from a small town handle the whole investigation. Once they realized the killer was targeting wives of firefighters there was no mention of any attempt to try to connect the firefighters in any way. Was there any thing that linked them? The killer shot all his victims with a 38 gun. When the detective finds out that one of the suspects had a 38 gun, why in the world he did not check to see it was the same gun? In addition the suspect breaks in the house of one of the victims and when surprised by the detective he tells a very weak story explaining his actions. Only after everybody knows the identity of the killer, does the detective remembers to check the story the suspect told about how he got the keys to the house. So overall it was a good reading. However if you are looking for a book with strong police investigation I recommend you look elsewhere.
