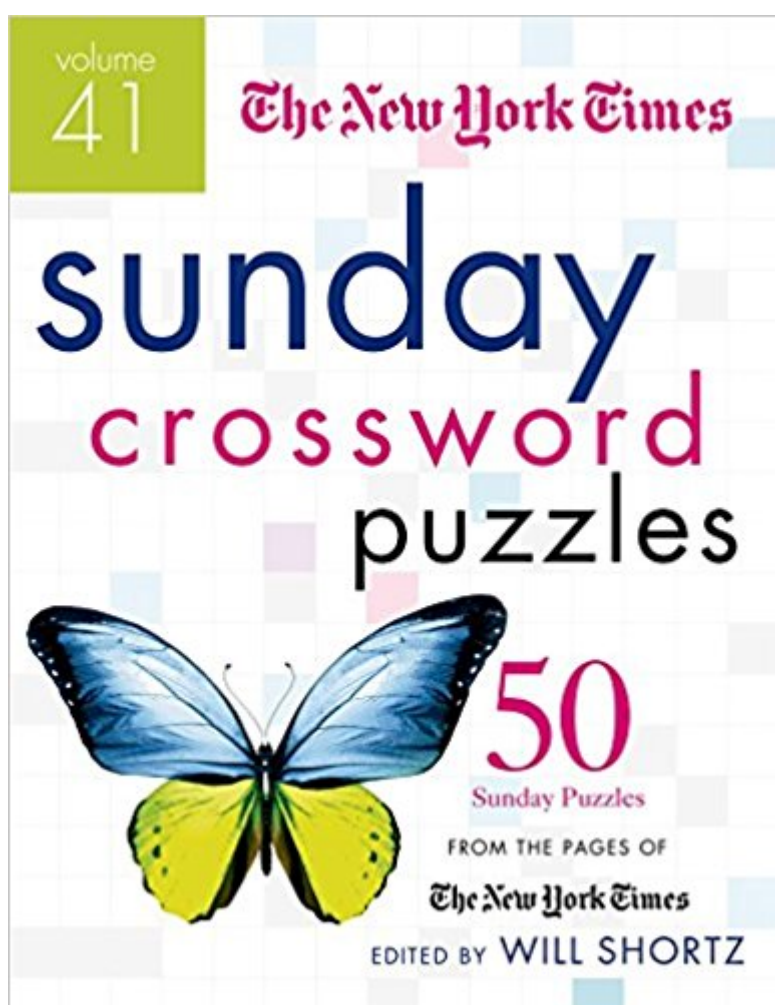

WILL SHORTZ has been the crossword puzzle editor of The New York Times since 1993. He is also the puzzlemaster on NPR’s Weekend Edition Sunday and is founder and director of the annual American Crossword Puzzle Tournament. He has edited countless books of crossword puzzles, Sudoku, KenKen, and all manner of brain-busters.

I’m glad the NYT keeps publishing these. However, this one is missing the puzzle titles, which takes away at least 25% of the fun.

There are no titles/descriptions for any of the 50 puzzles. It makes it a tad difficult to solve a puzzle, especially when for puzzle #7, clue 84 across is “[see instructions]”. What a huge disappointment. Didn’t realize these books were printed in China. Still no excuse for this oversight.

The font is smaller than in previous volumes. The puzzles are also missing the titles which were also present in previous volumes.

The puzzles are great - typical Sunday NYT quality. However, two negatives to report: 1. the print for the clues is VERY SMALL and some are misprinted (lower case L, upper case I, and exclamation mark are sometimes interchanged incorrectly) and 2. unbelievably, the title of each puzzle is NOT included with the puzzles. As anyone who does the NYT Sunday crossword knows, the title is a clue to the theme of the puzzle and is often instrumental in solving the clues that relate to the theme. This seems like a major oversight.

A big feature has been left out. None of the puzzles are titled, so there is no clue as to the direction it is taking.

I love this series of puzzles, and this is the 4th or 5th one I’ve gone through, working on them every morning at the breakfast table. What makes this book a little different is that every other book I’ve had in this series has a title that is a clue to the puzzle itself -- this one has no titles! A bit more challenging, but I’m up for it. One thing I do like about this series is the spiral binding, which makes it lay flat while I work on it.

Unfortunately the binding was broken and none of the puzzles had titles or instructions on them, the top of each page was blank. I wonder if this was a misprint that should have been discarded?

Like others have said, this puzzle book has no titles for the puzzles. The title is a key part of solving a puzzle, so it is kind of a big deal to leave the titles off. Anyway, a quick internet search led me to Macmillan Publishers (search for "sunday crossword puzzles volume 41 titles" Macmillan Publisher's web site for this puzzle book has a list of all 50 of volume 41's puzzles.

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
