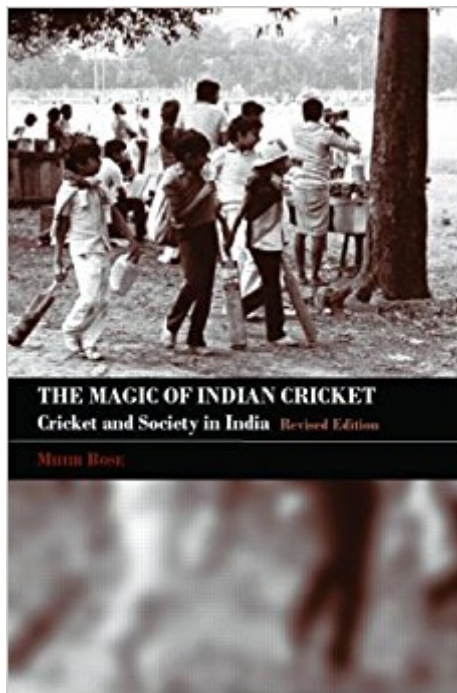




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The Magic Of Indian Cricket: Cricket And Society In India (Sport In The Global Society)
