

They state: Print Replica Kindle books maintain the rich formatting and layout of their related print editions and offer many of the advantages of standard Kindle books. Features include: Notes and highlights, Search, copy and paste, Zoom and pan, Pop-out linked table-of-contents. This is a problem - on 7" tablets or a first-gen iPad, it is impossible to read without zooming and panning.
