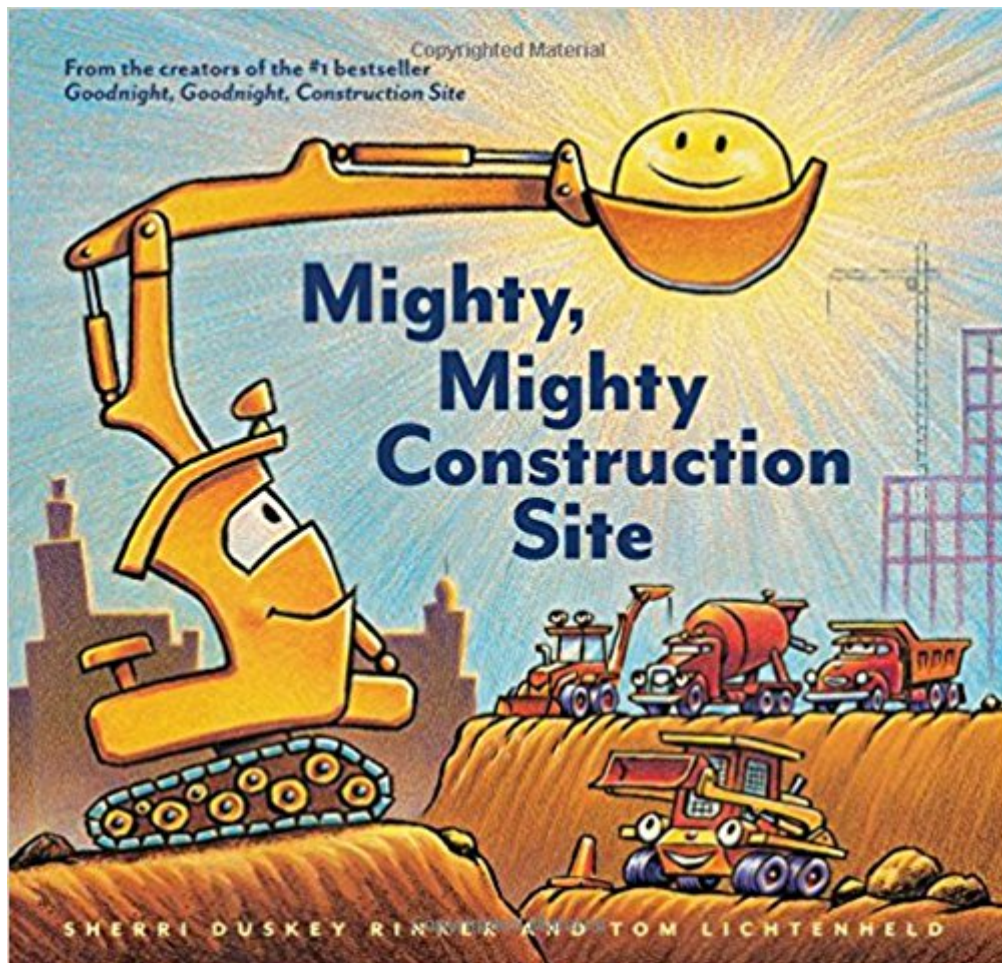

We finally received the book this evening and we have already read it 4 times before bed. Since I've read Goodnight, Goodnight Construction site over 100+ times already, I feel the flow of this book is similar. The rhymes were great, the illustrations were great, and best of all, my 3 year old LOVES this book. What a great addition to our book collection.

My son's favorite book starting at 18 months was Goodnight, Goodnight, Construction Site. When we got Steam Train, Dream Train, he loved that just as much, if not (at least at times) more. So I was absolutely thrilled to see this book release! My son, now 5, always wants to read it, and so does his little sister! I think it's so fun to have "girl trucks" as part of the team, and I see it already inspiring imaginative play with the two of them, even though my daughter isn't quite two yet. I also love that it takes the team through the whole day, and successful at the end, they can all go to sleep feeling content with their day's hard work. Another winner for sure!

Great follow up to "Goodnight, Goodnight Construction Site". Lots of new construction machines of both sexes, and fun rhymes for the daytime job. As the job finishes and the activity winds down, the

extra machines go home, and the original construction equipment goes to sleep at the end. Another nice bedtime story from this author.

A great sequel to the first book. I hope there are more books to come in this series. Our 3 and a half year old loves both books.

It's hard to beat the original. I mean, Good Night Good Night Construction Site is a perfect kids story. Fun to read over and over again and help your child calm down for sleep. But this book is a great accompaniment with the original 5 characters that have to work together with 5 new characters. Each truck has to team up with another truck to get the job done. It shows team work. The best part is how the book ties in the original book at the end. It's just perfect.

This book is fantastic! Goodnight Goodnight Construction Site is our absolutely favorite and we read it every night!. We were afraid this new one wouldn't live up to our expectation (we also have Steam Train Dream Train and don't love it nearly as much as GGCS). But this book met all of our expectations and then some!! It incorporates all of the great characters we know and love from the first, and adds in some new ones (including some girls). Mighty Mighty Construction Site covers teamwork and cooperation without being overly pushy about it. It has the same great illustrations and wonderful rhyming text. It ends with a very similar last page as GGCS. A perfect addition to our library! Well done!

My grandson loves this book. We have Good Night, Good Night Construction Site and this is a great compliment to it. My grandson reads both of them each night before going to bed. He is only 4 and 1/2 and has memorized almost all of both of the books.

Just as awesome as the first one. Love that they put some female characters in (my son loves the flat bed truck). And I also love the "co-operation/team work" aspect of the book.
