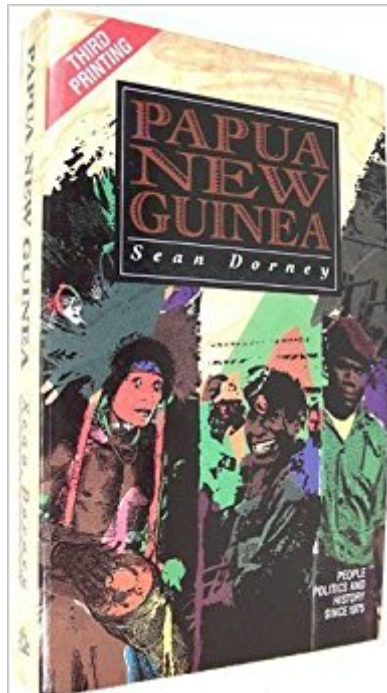




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Papua New Guinea: People, Politics And History Since 1975
