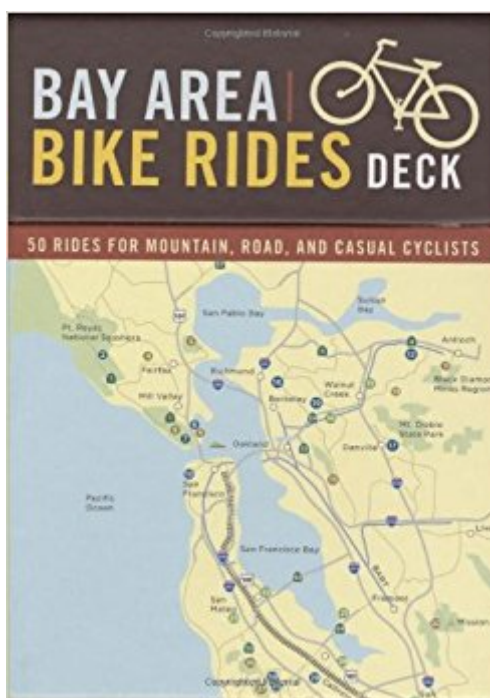

What a smart idea. This deck of 50 bike routes comes in a durable box that keeps the cards in good condition. The cards themselves are of a sturdy coated cardstock that you can easily take along with you, without having to lug an entire book. Brilliant!The cards are color coded - brown cards are off-road, green cards are paved and blue cards indicate a waterside route. Within these three categories, riders can select from a great variety of routes: long or short, hilled or flat, easy to difficult. You can travel on-road, over creeks, through mountains, around reservoirs, down hills and along the sea. Skill levels range from casual to expert.The 50 routes span a large geographical range throughout the Bay Area. Each card has a detailed map and excellent written instructions that are sure to keep you on route. My husband loves this deck. It was a great introduction to the fabulous bike routes of the San Francisco Bay Area. Recommended.

these are a great idea! everything you need but not much more - the map with only the roads you need, the elevation profile, brief route description and mileage log/legend that indicates turns, climbs, and even where to get water or food (you wouldn't get the info on locations of water fountains, foodmarkets or scenic outlooks from regular maps).The cards fit easily in the jersey backpack and are sweatproof. Easy to glance at/read while riding. Must have!
