

When discussing the topic of the SS Waffen, it is important to know as much about its history and background in the most factual way possible. Those on the wrong side of the soldiers will tell their experience with fear with this elite of elite German military group. The WW2 Waffen- SS Soldier Stories tell from the point of view of a few of the soldiers who served. As the author notes in the introduction, it was not written to praise the ideology that motivated the soldiers, but rather to recognize their bravery on the battlefield. For those who know little about the SS Waffen, they may be surprised that some of the soldiers were not German. Some came from other countries, like Leon Degrelle from the fascist party in Belgium. He did not hold back on his fascist beliefs and published his memoirs about the war. Others, like Hermann Maringgele, did not repeat much of the war to others, but documentation of his close combat awards and reports from where he was stationed speak of what he participated in. Overall, this book reminds readers the struggles of war and the horrors that were witnessed on the German side of the lines. It also showed the determination of those who fought in what they truly believed in.

It was an excellent overview in the formation of the Waffen SS presented by Ryan Jenkins, an advocate learner and experienced historian on the events and stories of World War II, World War I, and the Vietnam War. Ryan shared his experience and findings about the atrocities committed by the HitlerÃfÃcÃ Â Ã s elite force, the SS Waffen. This book is one of the best output of RyanÃfÃcÃ Â Ã s intensive research. History coming out from a researcher or an eyewitness account is always trustworthy and enjoyable read. I myself feel like an witness of the history. However, Waffen SS were the forces that were feared by the enemy for their brutality and inhumanity, on the contrary , they were praised by their allies for their courage. Ryan mainly focuses on the formation and the performance of the Waffen SS and also atrocities that were committed by the soldiers and examines the possible background of it. Besides this Ryan describes few stories

related to Waffen SS that will remind readers the struggles of war and the horrors that were witnessed on the German side of the lines. Ryan successfully showed the accomplishments and the failings of these elite soldiers. I appreciate his writing style and also his presentation based on true findings.

The Waffen SS was an elite troops who saw action on the every front except Africa during the second world war. The name Waffen SS (Armed SS) symbolizes the instilled fear and respect. Heinrich Himmler and Hitler was impressed at their high rated ferocity. There is a little confusing about the origin of the Waffen SS. This book described from eyewitness accounts of Hitler's Elite Troops will give you a crystal clear concept about its origin, power, activities and overall its story of growing ups to nearly forty divisions. This book shared many stories related to Waffen SS. I am surprised at Austrian Waffen SS Lieutenant Hermann Maringgle's certified records of taking part in eighty four hand to hand battles. Among those The Graveyard of the Waffen SS is notable and remembered to many German soldiers. You will know the story of becoming distinguished and being awarded the Gold German Cross through this book. Besides this, you could know about a Tank Destroyer named Vinzenz Kaiser who performed the most dangerous tasks without care or concern for his own life. Although he had received a recommendation for the Knight's Cross with Oak Leaves, he was not awarded officially. The author gathered so many stories related to Waffen SS those will remind you the brutality of Waffen SS and overall the violence of the World War.
