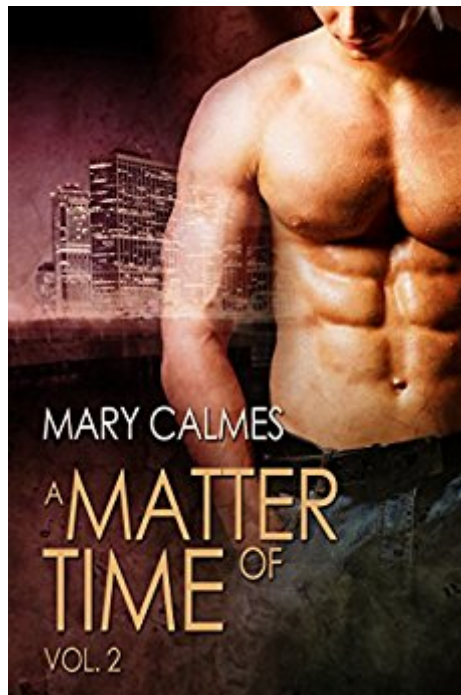




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A Matter Of Time: Vol. 2 (A Matter Of Time Series)
