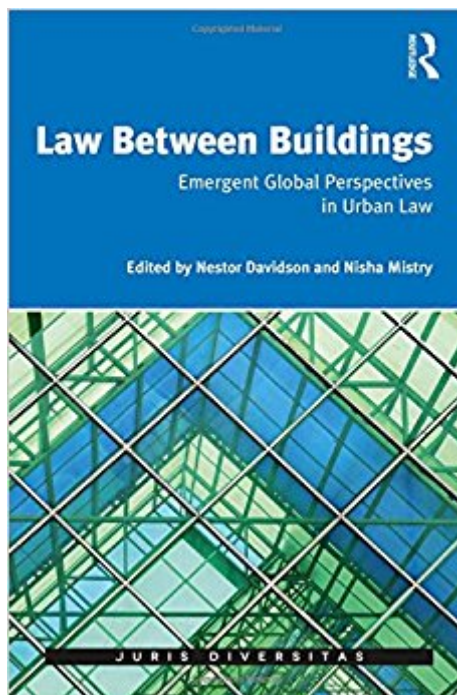




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# Law Between Buildings: Emergent Global Perspectives In Urban Law (Juris Diversitas)
