

Handy book, good for quick referencing when in the country.

I travel to Germany about once every decade -- just long enough to forget most of my language skills (two years of college-level German) and to need a refresher on culture. Dr. Bingham's books are my favorite way to reacclimatize to life in Germany. Her latest offering, "German Survival Culture," dispenses with the language component of "German Survival Guide" to create a quick-reading window into the basics of German culture (and manners!) for those who aren't planning on using any more German than "Guten Tag", "Danke", and "Wo ist die Toilette?" I think this book would be particularly useful for groups on tours where their immersion into the country and culture wouldn't necessarily require very much in the way of language skills. For the more adventurous who are willing to try the language with the locals, this book is probably not as good a fit as Bingham's "German Survival Guide."
