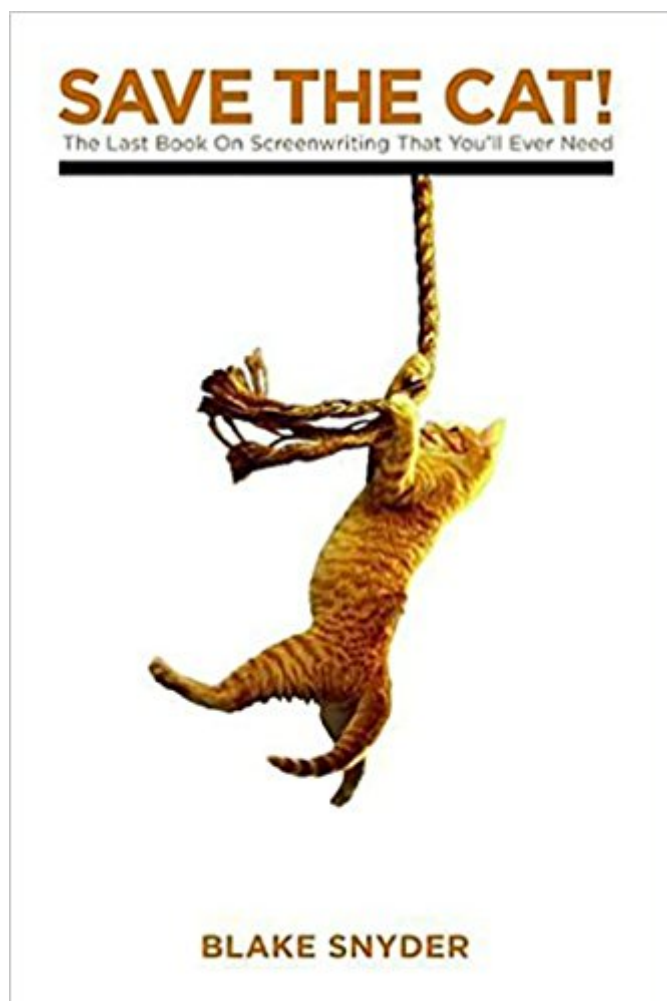

Halfway through reading this book I wanted to see the principles in action, so I checked TV Guide and saw that Tina Fey and Amy Poehler's Baby Mama was about to come on. I had not seen it, but figured if anyone knows how to write a movie, it's the two of them. So I watched it, with the Beat Sheet page of Blake Snyder's Save the Cat pulled up on my Kindle. And you know what? It followed it EXACTLY. When that movie ended they played the Tina Fey/Steve Carrel flick Date Night. I had seen that one, but I watched it again. It, too, unfolded exactly as Snyder suggests it should. I think this has forever altered how I watch movies, and I love that.
