Let me say up front that - with a few exceptions like Marcel Proust, William Faulkner, Ethan

Mordden and the first four (and ONLY the first four) Jay Bell SOMETHING LIKE novels - I almost invariably HATE "series" books and stories. They're just such gimmicks, usually "jumping the shark" with the appearance of the second installment. That being said, I actually did like - with a few caveats mentioned below - HE'S IT FOR ME and I wish I could give it 4 stars instead of 3. Two appealing (though somewhat cliché) college boys - one of them gay and the other obtuse and seemingly confused - meet on the first day of the new semester. Instant lust - and perhaps even love - follows. I don't mind "insta-love" - in my long life I've known more than a few long term gay couples who "fell in love" the first time they met. In fact, I'd rather read about "insta-love" than a lot of the other tropes that M4M romance writers toss off every time I turn on my Kindle. Declan and Matt honestly do seem right for one another. And, for the most part, I like the way this author handled their sweet love story - which includes just the right amount of sex. Unfortunately, about halfway through their tale, she DELIBERATELY misleads the reader with some totally false foreshadowing. It was so depressing that I almost didn't finish the book. In the end, however, it was all a lie on her part and I'm glad I stuck with it. That, coupled with obviously substandard editing and proofreading, is the reason I give this story only 3 stars instead of the 4 it would have earned otherwise. I rewrite all of my reviews at least 7 or 8 times. Why can't Kindle authors do the same thing?
