

However, he has no intentions whatsoever of doing that. He's bound for trouble and is intent on dragging Marissa right along with him.Notes: Speak No Evil is the 2nd in the Rusty Knoll Bible Camp series. The first book introduces

a group of about six campers and each of the three books in the series tells the story of one of the boys at camp and experiencing life change through his experiences at camp and the nightly chapel messages. This book deals with a kid whose dad has lost all faith in him due to the poor choices of his older brother. Jesse was the perfect one in the eyes of their father. It's until he found himself in jail. Now their dad is convinced that Taylor will be right behind him. Taylor was the camp bully in book one but this time he is too busy trying to keep his sister out of trouble to worry about causing trouble himself. It's the trust the old maintenance man places in him that causes Taylor to finally put his trust in Christ for his salvation. When he sees someone believing good of him instead of bad, he finally recognizes the truth. Jesus did for Taylor what Taylor is doing for Marissa. taking the punishment.
