

Stern Professor of Humanities and Art History, at the College at the University of Chicago, where he is also a coeditor of *Critical Inquiry* and an affiliate of the Departments of Classics and Cinema & Media Studies. He is also Executive Editor of *Critical Inquiry*. He works on the intersection of aesthetics, archaeology, and art history, with particular

emphasis on Classical Greek and neo-Classical French art. Interests include the development of naturalism; Archaic and Classical Athens; the circle of Nicolas Poussin and Claude Lorrain; phenomenology; and theories of style.
