

I was pretty disappointed when I opened this book, was going to be a Christmas present for my 8 year old daughter. Very graphic and disgusting, I do not recommend.

This book is a funny but short historical account of Cleopatra, the last Ptolemy. Cleopatra was no saint so expect there to be several references to her family's less than stellar way of handling problems, usually solved through murder. And she was quite the seducer too. This book is not for young children. It is for older students and is really just a quick introduction to this famous Egyptian Queen. This book chronicles her power hungry family, her romance with Julius Ceaser and Marc Antony (this portion is really more along the lines of telling rather than showing.) There are some sidebars about life in Egypt that are sort of tongue in cheek but still filled with facts. Overall I liked this book, it tells the quick story of a very self confident and self serving queen.
