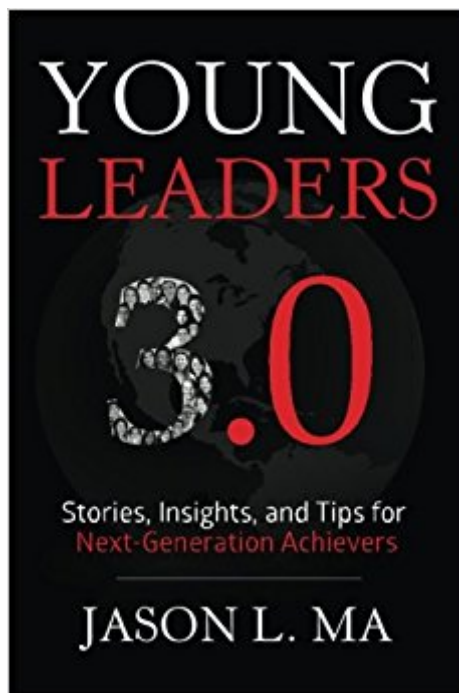




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Young Leaders 3.0: Stories, Insights, And Tips For Next-Generation Achievers
