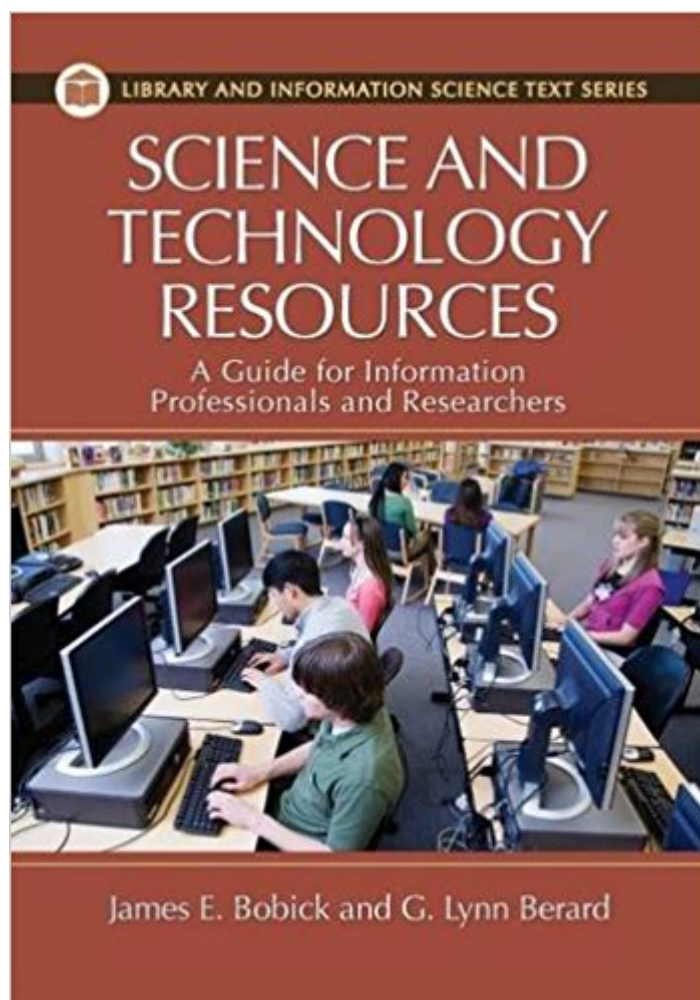


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Science And Technology Resources: A Guide For Information Professionals And Researchers (Library And Information Science Text)





Synopsis
