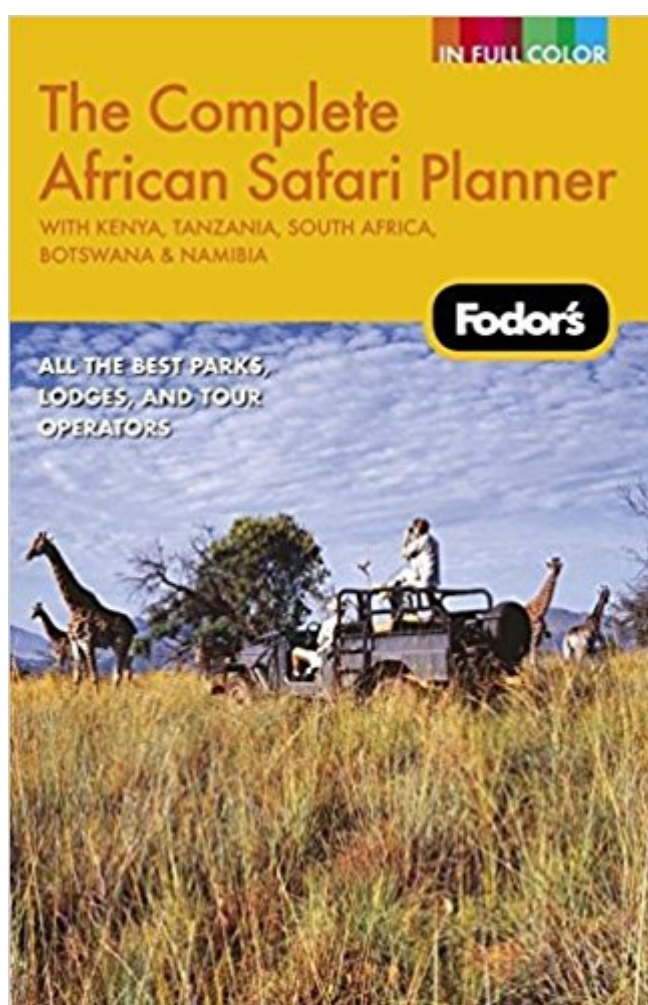

This is a good (not great) first book to give an idea what your trip to Africa might be like. Be forewarned, though, that it does not address some areas that many people might consider essential: especially there is no information on gorilla tracking in Uganda (nothing on the "pearl of Africa" at all) or Rwanda. It would be a serious mistake to not consider these areas, even if you are (like me) over 50. We are planning a trip for summer '11, and we do use this book, but we rely much more heavily on country-specific books like Philip Briggs' book on Tanzania. I think Fodor's will generally lead you to the most well-known (if not popular) areas. A good start, but if your planning ends with this book, you'll miss a lot. The guidebook covers Tanzania, South Africa, Botswana, Namibia and Kenya. With colored photos and detailed descriptions of what each region and park has to offer, the guide covers safaris from luxury to shoestring. Among the many features are charts of seasonal access to parks by month and where to find specific animals; recommendations based on considerations, such as, if you like to bring the kids and animal encounter; and a safari planning timeline starting six months before your trip.

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
