

Ian Hancock received his Ph.D. from London University and teaches Romani studies at the University of Texas, Austin, where he is the director of the Romani Archives and Documentation Center. He was born in Britain but descends on his father's side from the Benczi Imre family, which left Hungary in the second half of the 19th century. In 1998 President Clinton appointed him to represent Romanies on the United States Holocaust Memorial Council. he is the author of over 300 books and articles, mostly on the Roma.

Hancock is able to summarize and clarify a lot about the Romani that I have previously read. One thing that bothered me at first but got past it quickly, is that when he talks about the Romani he uses the personal possesive, i.e. ....was done to us, we don't like...., But I think that heightens the personal perspective and in the final analysis doesn't compromise the scholarship.I think it is an easy book to read and is well referenced. I also recommend Isable Fonseca's book, "Bury Me Standing" for additional information.

In Europe, the 12 million Roma constitute its largest ethnic minority, a marginalized and much maligned minority whose contributions to Western culture are often ignored.Ian Hancock, himself of Romani heritage, and currently a professor of linguistics at the University of Texas, Austin, introduces his book: "One purpose of this book is to deconstruct the stereotype of fictional 'gypsies' and to replace it with a picture of the real population -- the Romanies." In a later chapter, Hancock presents brief biographies of more than a hundred Romani luminaries, such as: \*Sonya Kavalesky, who, in 1884, became the first woman university professor in Sweden, teaching mathematics; \*Charles Chaplin, the legendary filmmaker; \*Patricia Lafcadio Hearn, who in the late nineteenth century "was one of the first to establish the modern-day journalistic style of writing

This caused a renew interest in the gypsy people. This book of dzene is in very simple language but it is filled with information about the origin of these people, the treatment they were subjected to in their travels, and also recommendations of how to relate to them. This is a wonder contribution to the libraries of the world.
