

Any fan of Amber knows that there are a few things you can expect in her books. One - she's not afraid to deal with difficult or hard subjects, Two - typically her heroine's are the virginal type and Three - a christian undertone. Play hard hits two of the three typical's for Amber. Play Hard addresses some difficult subject and has the christian undertone BUT this time the heroine isn't so virginal (THANK GOD!!). I'm going to jump on my soapbox for a moment and state that the whole Manw\*&re/Virgin trope is tired and over used. I'm all for a reformed bad guy but why can't the girl play some too? I'm tired of authors making it like the heroine has to be pure or shes less than and I'm tired of every hero having to sleep with the whole female population to be cool. Ultimately I don't want my hero or my heroine to be hooking up with numerous people BUT I do want it to be somewhat realistic and have the leads on level ground. Now, back to the book. I enjoyed this book more than the first in this series. I didn't exactly have that high of an opinion of Cal after reading the first book but this one did earn him some love. He proved that he didn't have to fall in with the "in crowd" and proved his affection for Taylor. While some of his actions weren't exactly believable (no teenage guy would EVER do some of the things he did) I did like how he fell for, treated, and respected Taylor. Taylor was a hurt girl and she was paying for her actions. She faced the consequences the best she could. She had a lot of anger in her and it was portrayed in a realistic fashion. I had a lot of respect for Taylor. I also enjoyed that Taylor's aunt and uncle weren't portrayed as "over the top" Christians. I feel that their beliefs were represented well and as with Taylor in a very believable fashion. Cal and Taylor coming together was a beautiful story and even though the ending left you with some unanswered questions (hopefully we will get them answered in

the next book) I do believe that they are together for the long run. Amber did a great job at showing the love and RESPECT they had for each other. This is a book that I would recommend for teenagers more so than the first one as this one deals with the more realistic subject while showing that there are consequences for those actions.

So Taylor is 16 and moves to a new town to live with her aunt & uncle. While before she had friends and a boyfriend now she doesn't have anyone really. So when the star pitcher of the high school baseball team takes notice in her she has no choice but to let him no matter how hard she pushes him away. Cal is the star pitcher of the Prairie Creek baseball team. He could have any girl he wants but instead goes after the new shy, quiet girl. What he doesn't expect is for her to have a big life changing secret. Great read that makes you feel so many emotions! But you can't help but fall in love with Cal and Taylor. Yeah by the time you get through your wishing things would have turned out a little differently but this is still a great book and a great series!!

This is the second book in the series. I loved the first one so much that I was nervous when I started this one. But honestly, I think I might have liked it more and that shocked me. As I am finding out with Amber's books, there are twists in all of her books and this is no different. This book is about Emmy's brother Cal and the new girl that comes to school, Taylor. Taylor has a big secret. They are from different worlds but have undeniable chemistry. Again, the characters are so well written. Plus you get to see a continuation of Emmy and Chris's relationship from the first book.
