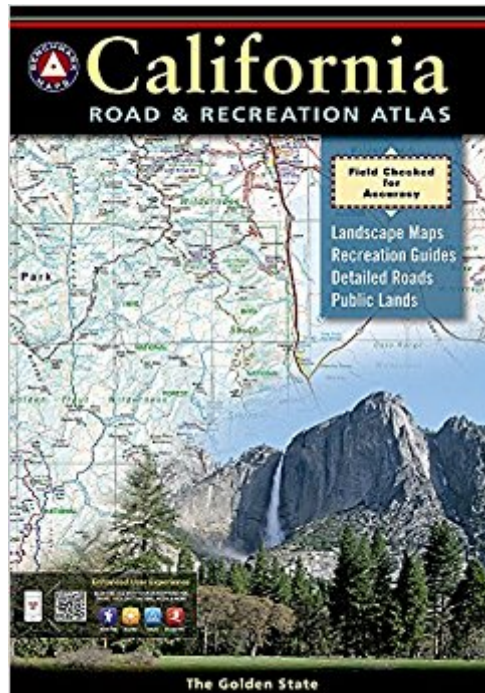

This has been a pretty solid addition to my adventures. There have been a bunch of times on BLM land where the book shows roads where they are gated and private. This seems especially bad in rangeland in the coast range (mostly south of the bay). Besides that, it's solid.

I've enjoyed the Benchmark atlases for years because they are (were) so easy to read. I much preferred them to the Delorme atlases for this reason -- they included enough information but not so much that it was cluttered. My old California atlas was wearing out so I upgraded -- but don't care for the new one. It's so much harder to read that we kept the old and will use it most of the time, referring to the new one on occasion. Benchmark has now included so much detail -- every tiny stream, for example -- that it's hard to read. Surely they have professionals on staff who know when enough is enough and when it's too much. Still, it's a good atlas, but I'd look at the alternatives before buying it and I won't automatically upgrade any of my other older atlases without checking out the new version and the competition.

These books are great for detail of landmarks, points of interests, altitude, and trails. I already had Nevada but found more information in this book for a road that was in California that headed back to Nevada. I had to check and make sure it was open because the book said "closed in winter" and the Nevada book did not state that. I would love to have one of these for each state we will travel in but I

think my husband would limit me on that. These are the best books for detail of every corner of the state and detail maps of bigger areas as well.

Devoted to the Benchmark series, and this new edition didn't disappoint me. I love the new level of detail, and didn't find it cluttered the maps. Can't even count how many times we've used this map to explore wilderness and backcountry areas of the state, or simply to navigate around traffic jams on the interstates. Not so useful for urban areas, however; if you're visiting LA, SF, Orange County or San Diego, you'll need to supplement with city maps.

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
