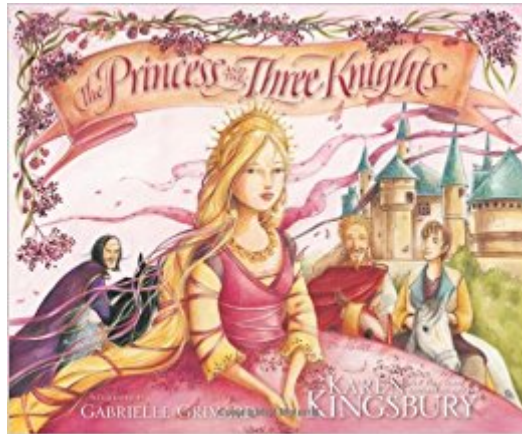




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The Princess And The Three Knights

Deciding that only a knight who treasured the princess for who she was on the inside is worthy of her hand, the king sets up a series of trials for his daughter’s would-be suitors, including essays on loyalty and faith. In the final challenge, the knights must imagine that they are carrying the princess and race their horses closest to the cliff’s edge. Only the third and last knight refuses to participate: “I love the princess . . . I wouldn’t take her anywhere near that cliff.” Even by fairy-tale

standards, the king's last test is an odd concept, but it ably illustrates Kingsbury's strong message: "True love always protects." • Grimard's cheerful, mixed-media artwork adheres closely to fairytale conventions, starting with the blond, blue-eyed princess, but the bright, attractive scenes will easily hold children's attention. I bought this for my nearly 4 year old grand daughter who listened to it three times in one day. There is even enough action in it to interest her 7 year old brother. After reading it we all three discussed how men should protect women and that what's in our hearts is more valuable than anything else.

Beautifully illustrated and a very sweet story that all girls need to hear! (Your son will learn something from it as well!) It is a story about different knights wanting to win the princess and what character qualities make up the right prince.

My daughter was enchanted by this story. I like the fact that the chivalrous knight, who eventually wins the competition, chooses not to imperil the princess' life in order to win (and, of course, this is how he beats out the other two). The religious overtones are there, but not glaring to my mind. Some stronger agnostics might be put off, but I took this as an opportunity to talk about religious beliefs. Others will be disappointed that there isn't more elaboration on the way the knight's faith contributes to his strength.

Great book for the 'tween' girl. This is a neat story of how a princess's heart is won by the wisest suitor. My 9 year old understood it perfectly. This is a great way to teach younger girls to be discerning about the boys...good and bad around them. This is a book that we will take off the shelf and read through for years to come. I would also say that this is an excellent bedtime story to read with your daughter. It's not long, but is though provoking and is a good conversation starter about boys when that time comes in her life.

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
