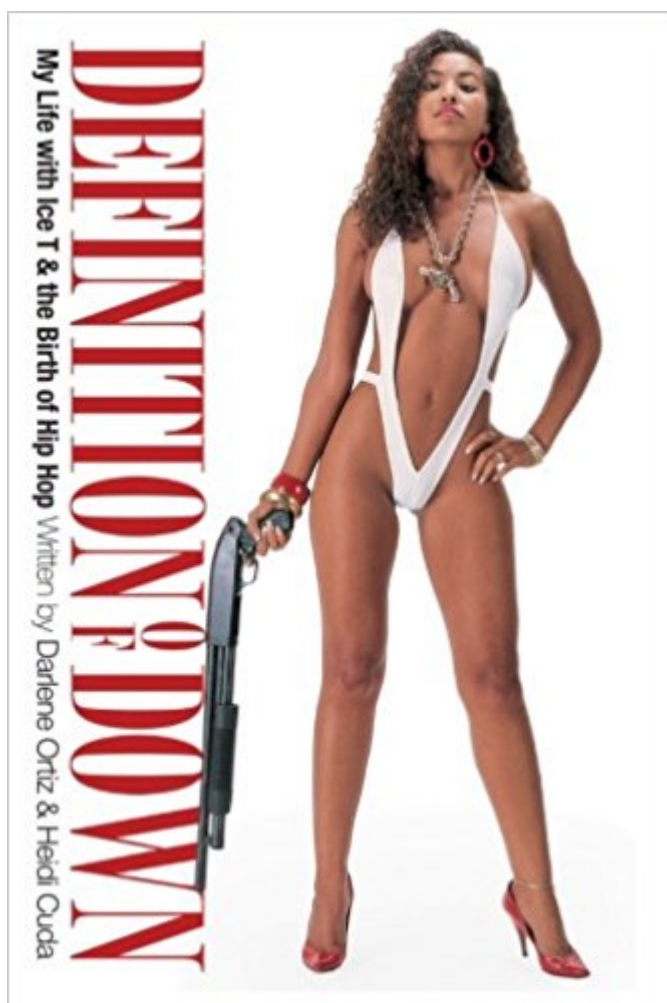


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Definition Of Down: My Life With Ice T & The Birth Of Hip Hop - B/w Version
