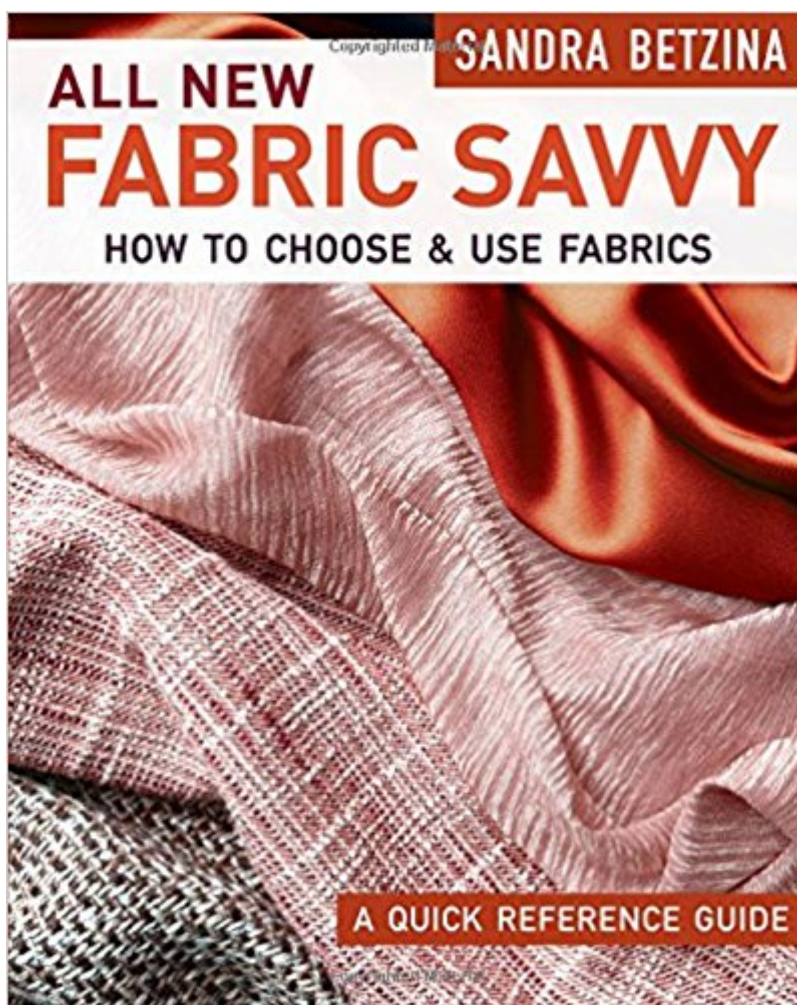

However, the information necessary to be successful and obtain the information I was looking for is all there.

I love this book!! It provides information on preshrinking, marking, cutting, seam finishing 107 different fabrics. It tells you what to look for, and what to avoid in a specific fabric. There's a finished piece for each fabric as an example, which is very inspirational.
