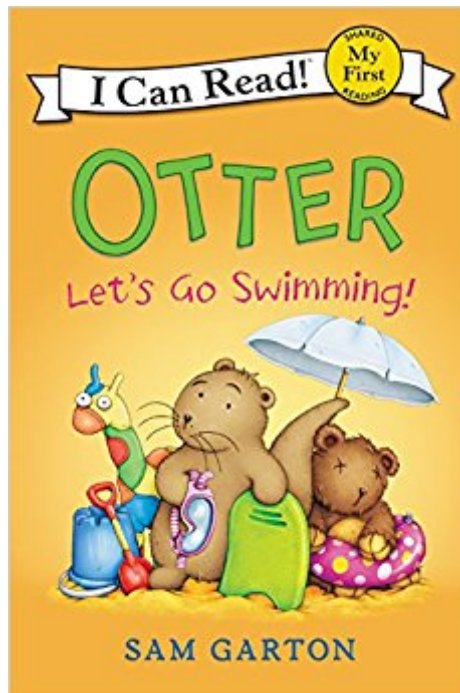

She's going to the seashore, and she's terribly excited, but she's a little afraid of swimming. (Actually, this is true to life: baby river otters have to be taught to swim by their mums, and baby sea otters are too buoyant to swim at first. None of them are too thrilled about taking the plunge initially.) So she comes up with typically otter excuses for not swimming. But we get through the day, and our fears, in a typically Otter way. The book is illustrated with the charming illustrations that Otter lovers have come to expect: engaging, delightful, and just plain fun. Children who are learning to read will enjoy reading this book, since it's an "I Can Read" book... while adults will enjoy reading it aloud while sharing it with smaller children who can sound out words and look at the pictures.
