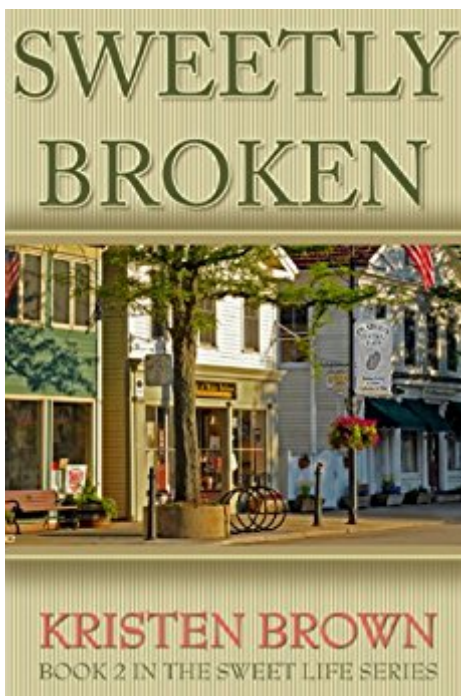


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Sweetly Broken (The Sweet Life Book 2)

I don't want to spoil any of the story so I will not go in to detail about the book. Read the first one and order this one at the same time because you will not want to wait to start the next book once you finish the first. Usually I don't care for books written in the first person, but the author makes it very readable and fast paced. Usually I can figure the 'culprit' early but only guessed about 3/4 through and had not a clue why. However I am a 'proofreader' by heart and was a little disappointed that more care has not been used to make sure there were no errors. But most of all the Christian theme rings wonderfully true!

This book was even better than Kristen Brown's first book. I thought the first book started slowly, even though the character background was necessary. The second book gets right into the plot. The characters are delightful, and even though the problems reach an almost comical point, it is somehow credible. Reading it is a light and enjoyable way to spend an afternoon. One reviewer of Ms. Brown's first book questions its Christian label. I don't agree with that reviewer, but I would add that the second book presents a stronger Christian message without being unrealistic.

OK, it's better edited than the first book in the series, which made it easier to read for me. This book had me craving pea soup on a hot Fourth of July weekend. The characters are fun, there's mystery, and a little romance thrown in. Very enjoyable. Samantha and her sisters are really a handful and then you add in the guests to her B & B and the world is turned upside down. I thought I had it figured out and of course, I didn't. Another good read from an up and coming New York Times bestseller.

Once again, Kristen Brown has captured my complete attention reading one of her books. I loved this story, "Sweetly Broken" (sequel to her first book, "Home Sweet Home") very, very much.
