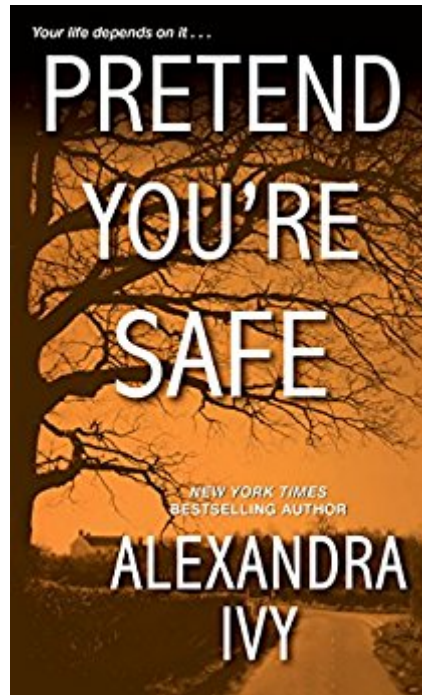




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Pretend You're Safe (The Agency)

I hadn't read any of this author's books before but the synopsis sounded interesting and I was willing to give this book a chance. It was just okay. The writing was competent. But I felt the language was boilerplate and all of the characters felt wooden and one-dimensional. Also this is touted as a romantic suspense novel and I guessed the antagonist right off the bat and the romance was lukewarm at best. If you're looking for a book that you can read and not have to pay much attention to, this will fit that slot. But, for me, there are too many books and too little time to enjoy them. I want more from my reading material than I got with this book. And I notice it's the first book in a series. The author needs to rethink this book before putting out book two.

Jaci Patterson has returned to her hometown hoping that things have changed while she was gone and praying that the torment she experienced in her teenage years doesn't return. Things were going fine for Jaci until a huge storm washed a body into a neighboring farm. Jaci is immediately on edge because years before she had found her first locket on her porch with a few strands of hair wrapped around a scrap of bloodstained ribbon and no one would believe that it was more than a prank. Rylan Cooper had been an arrogant deputy sheriff back when Jaci was trying to get someone to believe there were more to the gifts left for her. Now Rylan sees that Jaci is truly being stalked when another locket is left after the discovery of the body. Now Rylan admits that Jaci may have just been right with insisting a serial killer was on the loose and he now vows to do whatever he can to find them before anything can happen to Jaci.

Pretend You're Safe by Alexandra Ivy is a romantic suspense read. As with most romantic suspense there is some language and sexual situations involved that you don't normally find in a regular mystery/thriller but the story also contains the chilling story of a killer on the loose tormenting the main character along with the developing relationship. As this one started off I was wondering if Jaci was going to end up struggling with a love triangle in the story line but thankfully she chooses her interest fairly early on even after two potential men were brought into the story. She was a strong character that was determined to not let the killer torment her yet again and was easily likable from the start. The book also contained a few twists and turns on the mystery side to keep it interesting while focusing on the relationship too so both sides were enjoyable. I received an advance copy from the publisher via NetGalley.

This cover tells you everything about this book. It's a bit creepy, it's a small town and it's dangerous. Just the vibes from the cover alone caused me to request this book from NetGalley. There's always been this lurking threat of a stalker since Jaci was 16, but no one took it seriously until years later and he's back. Not only does she have this idiot stalking her and possibly murdering other women but she has her stodgy rich family to contend with. A mother and step father, half brother and half sister and not a whole lot of sense or love among them. There were times I wanted to reach into the book and yell some words at her mother. Luckily for Jaci she has strong and trustworthy men that are willing to look out for her. Ivy wove an intriguing and frightening story that kept me reading well into the night trying to solve her case. Apparently there will be more in this series and I'm sure she won't disappoint.

Jaci Patterson has a stalker, it started years ago. Gold lockets with bloody hair have been left as

presents for her. When they first started appearing local law enforcement dismissed her fears. Jaci left town for awhile and the gifts stopped. Now after a flood in the area a dead body shows up. The lockets start appearing again and local women disappear. Law enforcement is taking it seriously this time. Mike O'Brien, local sheriff and Rylan Cooper both want to protect Jaci. Both are interested in her romantically. This is a good romantic suspense. Jaci is a strong character who knows what she wants. There is romance, with two heroes to choose from. It could be a love triangle but Jaci makes her choice clear early on. There is suspense and plenty of twists that will keep you guessing who the bad guy is.
