Short work on container gardening. Covers basic principles, but too simplistic. Brief discussion of pesticides was discouraging. Don't use pesticides on container plants.

It peaks your interest about container gardening. It is not a good how to book . It gives very basic information on plants. On one planting time suggestion. No guide about how to check soil or what plant works better in the soils it mentioned to use. Leaves you with more questions. But if you are asking them them you might want to try the container gardening.

Bad kindle formatting for tables. Information seemed lacking. No real directions/instructions - just general information. The summary seemed misleading, I didn't realize this "book" (more like a pamphlet, very short) would be more like an overview. Agree with previous commenter that there was no real "action plan".

This is little more than a pamphlet (40 pages including article resources), with a few charts, and even fewer grainy black and white photos. When I went to my local library I found many other much more helpful titles, among them: "Crops in Pots "by Bob Purcell, which has plant combinations to

put in larger containers, an extensive plant glossary, and recipes using each of the container designs. I also liked "Grow Vegetables in Pots" which is a DK Publishing title. This book also includes herbs and fruit-bearing trees and bushes for container planting, plus a good section on pests and diseases.

I learned several new things as a beginning gardener from this book. I'm eager to start growing vegetables in containers at one and thanks to this book I have all the information I need!
